HCP limit	Man 0.0 - 28.9; Ladies 0-30.8
HCP status	Every participant must confirm his active handicap by registration in the list of handicaps of Russian Golf Association (for citizens of Russia), or determined on the basis of another national procedure to determine handicaps, compatible with the requirements of the European Golf Association (for citizens of other states). If a player's handicap is not confirmed or not active, it is subject to disqualification.
Caddies and spectators	Caddies and spectators are allowed
Participation fee	Club Members: 4 000 rub; Guests: 8 000 rub; Juniors Club Members: 2 000 rub; Guest Juniors: 4 000 rub.

HCP Groups, Format and Tees	Group 1 – Men with exact HCP 0.0 – 14.0 Strokeplay Nett, yellow tee; Group 2 – Men with exact HCP 14.1 – 28.9 Stableford , yellow tee; Group 3 – Ladies with exact HCP 0.0 – 20.0 Strokeplay Nett , red tee; Group 4 – Ladies with exact HCP 20.1 – 30.8 Stableford , red tee; Overall Men's Stableford Winner Overall Ladies's Stableford Winner
Group validity and prize allocation	<i>There needs to be a minimum of 8 participants per group to qualify for the category to be valid. If this is not the case, the participants will merge with majority of players, forming a single category, competing in the format stipulated for majority group. Ranking points however will still be awarded for each indicated category. Each category will be awarded prize allocations to the top 3 participants in each category. Players are not allowed to win more than one prize and will be offered the best prize for his results with regards to category and position defaulted to the next player.</i>
Determination of the winner	<i>Stableford tie</i> – lowest exact handicap wins, if still tied, best back nine holes, then best last six holes then best last 3 holes <i>Stroke Nett tie</i> – Count back on the last nine holes, half the handicap is applied, for the final six holes, a third of the handicap, and a sixth of the handicap for the last three holes.
Extra nominations	Men and ladies: Longest drive; Nearest to the pin.

Tournament Cancellation Policy	The golf course enforces a firm 24 hour cancellation policy . Please note: any time prior to 24 hours before your tee time, you may cancel or modify your tee time with absolutely no penalty. If you cancel your participation past the 24 hour deadline, the subsequent penalty will be incurred. The player will be suspended from the next tournament date on the calendar and denied participation in the event. There will be exception to the rule with mitigating circumstances at the discretion of the Director of Golf.
Pace of Play	In the Rules of Golf, Rule 6-7 is the relevant Rule in relation to undue delay and slow play. It provides that "The player must play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play guidelines that the Committee may establish". The penalty for a breach of Rule 6-7 is loss of hole in match play and two strokes in stroke play, and for a repeated offence, disqualification. Guidelines will be in place and rule will be enforced accordingly.
